OTHER FEES

All skaters must be registered with Skate Canada and pay an annual membership fee. This fee covers a full year of skating from September 2018 - August 2019. The Skate Canada and administration fee is **\$36** and it is non-refundable.

OFF-ICE AND GROUP LESSONS

Off-ice sessions are also offered to intermediate/senior skaters as part of the skating program. These sessions are included in the fees on the days the program is offered and skaters should plan on attending these sessions if skating on those days.

COMPETITION AND TEST DAY

Yukon Gold Nugget Championships and Test day will be held on **November 30/December 1, 2018**. A second test day will be held at the end of the season.

ICE SHOW

The club will also be hosting an ice show this year at Takhini Area on **February 16, 2019**. All Starskaters will be encouraged to participate. More information will follow about this exciting event in the new year.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS
