

## **Volunteer Screening Policy**

Date in effect: June 2018

Arctic Edge Skating Club, hereinafter referred to as the 'Club' or 'AESC', values mutual respectfulness, respectful interaction, and open communication. To support our desire to foster a respectful environment for skaters, coaches, board members and families the following policy has been established.

- 1. All coaches over 18 years of age shall obtain an RCMP background check as per Skate Canada rules and regulations.
- All parents or guardians working directly with skaters for significant periods of time, or working in isolation with skaters, shall, at the request of the Executive, obtain an RCMP background check.
- 3. All member of the AESC Executive a required to complete the online Respect in Sport modules offered by Sport Yukon, within 2 months of being elected to the Executive.
- 4. Participants in the Early Academy, STARSkate, and Competitive programs are required to have one parent per family complete the online Respect in Sport modules.
- 5. It is suggested that for participants in the CanSkate, Tots, CanPower, and Special Olympics, one parent per family complete the online Respect in Sport modules.
