

2020 Arctic Winter Games
Yukon Figure Skating Team Trials & Team Selection Criteria

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the Yukon Figure Skating Team Trial, all participants must:

- Be Skate Canada members in good standing as of November 1, 2019
- Meet the 2020 Team Yukon Arctic Winter Game Eligibility Requirements for the AWG Figure Skating on or before December 7, 2019
- Register to compete in one of the Categories of The Yukon Arctic Winter Game Trials by November 1, 2019.
- Meet the Trial Event Test Criteria on or before December 6, 2019 for the AWG Trial Category they are registered in; Level 1 entrants will have passed Skate Canada STAR 3 Program and Elements assessment (or equivalent) and **not** STAR 5 Program and Elements assessment (or equivalent), Level 2, Level 3, and Level 4 entrants will have passed Skate Canada STAR 5 Program and Elements assessments (or equivalent).

Trial Event Categories

AWG Level 1: Entrants will compete AWG 2020 Level 1 Freeskate program.

AWG Level 2: Entrants will compete the AWG 2020 Level 2 Freeskate and Level 2 Short program

AWG Level 3: Entrants will compete the AWG 2020 Level 3 Freeskate and Level 3 Short program

AWG Level 4: Entrants will compete the AWG 2020 Level 4 Freeskate and Level 4 Short program

Each AWG Level and well-balanced program requirements for the Freeskate programs, and Short programs will be as per the AWG 2020 technical package. The program duration indicates the maximum (MAX) timing. This means that a program duration is up to the maximum time indicated for each Level. ISU (International Skating Union) levels of difficulty and scale of values will apply.

Team Selection

A maximum of 8 skaters will be named to the 2020 Yukon Arctic Winter Games Figure Skating Team Roster based on the following criteria:

- The two skaters having the highest combined scores in the short program and free program for each of AWG Trial Categories of Level 4, Level 3, and Level 2, **and**, the two skaters having the highest score in the Free program for the Level 1 Event.
- If fewer than 2 skaters are competing at any AWG trial event Level and there are 3 or more entrants in one or more other event levels, a third place skater from the highest event level(s) would be selected until the team roster of 8 is filled (ie Level 4 first, then Level 3, then Level 2 and then Level 1).

After the team is selected the next highest ranked entrant from each of the event Levels will be identified to act as a substitute should a selected team member be removed from the roster. Alternates may be assigned to the team roster in an appropriate event level at the discretion of the Team coaches.

APPEALS

Any appeals regarding competition proceedings, program scores or rankings will be addressed as per Skate Canada Protest rules.

Any concerns, questions or appeals regarding team selection shall be made in writing to the Chair of Arctic Edge Skating Club, Fabienne Brulhart, arcticedgechairs@gmail.com, within 48 hours of the naming of the team. A three person committee will be established by the Chair to hear and render a written decision on any disputes regarding the selection of the team roster within 7 days of receiving the appeal.
