

Arctic Edge Skating Club Expectations For Members, Volunteers and Participants;

Get Vaccinated the Chief medical health officer advises that in order to ensure the health and safety of all members anyone eligible to be vaccinated should get vaccinated.

Self-Monitor for COVID symptoms.

Stay home-Do not attend any club activity if Covid symptoms are present (even if mild)

Practice Hand Hygiene upon arrival at Canada Games Center and immediately prior to engaging in scheduled AESC activity.

Avoid sharing of personal belongings. All skaters should bring their own water bottle.

Ensure 2 meter physical distance is maintained between all Coaches, Volunteers, Skaters, and Parents/Guardians whenever possible.

The Skater Designated rink side area and Dressing Rooms may only be entered by Coaches, Skaters and Scheduled Volunteers.

Music box area may only be entered by Scheduled Volunteers or Coach

Face Coverings that cover nose and mouth are strongly recommended by the chief medical health officer in public areas when not engaged in sport activity. We encourage masks to be worn by all adults, coaches, program assistants and volunteers and skaters while in skater designated areas at rink side or in meeting rooms.
